

To ensure alignment with the Gerosa Group's policy, Rieusset's specific occupational safety objectives have been defined in close agreement with the Gerosa Group's global guidelines and commitments. Our approach seeks to reinforce the established standards by actively contributing to its global goals through concrete and measurable actions adapted to the context of Rieusset's organization.

To this end, the objectives that have been set are the following:

- Maintaining and constantly improving the Occupational Health and Safety Management System based on the ISO 45001 standard
- Introducing occupational health and safety considerations into our decision making process
- Developing our activity under the principle of Safety, Quality and Efficiency where Safety is the first element to keep in mind
- Steadily **reducing** the number of accidents to 0 accidents with and without sick leave and the value of the accident rate
- Working on the actions of the preventive activity planning by carrying out a minimum of 35 actions/quarter (without counting the discarded ones)
- Reviewing specific occupational safety objectives on an annual basis
